

Unravel historical treasures with a global flair, including gates from Venice, statues from Rome, and antiquated Irish allure in Avoca, a charming terrace café. Perfect for leisurely walks or lengthy exploration, Powerscourt Estate and Gardens brings nature to life within the bustle of a busy city.



Known as 'the valley of the two lakes', Glendalough is a true escape from the rush and pull of Dublin. A hotbed for hikers and walkers alike, Glendalough is rich in history and scenery, with a restorative sense of tranquillity. Make the short climb to the top and luxuriate in unfiltered views of swirling scenery and gentle lakes. While there, visit Monastic sites including historic churches, high crosses, and round towers dating back to the 6th -century. Be sure to check out the Visitor Centre too with its guided tours, exhibition and illuminating audio-visual shows.

Cross the Shannon Estuary by ferry.


Killarney Town

Built nearly 600 years ago by Cormac MacCarthy, one of Ireland's greatest chieftains, Blarney Castle is an icon of the Irish countryside. Best known as the home of the Blarney Stone kiss it, legend says, and you'll inherit the gift of the gab it's also got much to offer any passing visitors. Relax into the tranquillity of the beautiful gardens and soak up the magic of Rock Close, with its fairy glade and waterfalls, before climbing the steps of the castle itself to kiss the world famous Blarney Stone and gain the gift of eloquence. You will also have the chance to visit the Woollen Mills today too.

Rock of Cashel

Originally the seat of the kings of Munster, the Rock of Cashel is one of the most spectacular historical sites in Ireland. Sittiing majestically atop a high outcrop of limestone in Ireland's Golden Vale in Tipperary, the ancient medieval buildings are positioned right in the heart of Ireland.

The remarkable site includes a 15th-century Tower house, a high cross, a Gothic cathedral an abbey and Cormac's Chapel, home to the only surviving Romaneque frescoes in Ireland.
